1. Introduction

The 18 Beneficiaries of Heritage Plus (from 15 Countries) identified in **a two step-Joint Call** the core of the Project, with the objective of endorsing innovative research initiatives in the field of cultural heritage.

The call procedure has been divided into two phases, Pre-call and Full-call, in order to guarantee an accurate and objective selection of the proposals. While Pre-proposals showed the projects in all their general components, Full-proposals were supposed to delve deeper into relevant issues by providing more details regarding the Description of Work, the management structure and the budget. Applicants have been required to submit innovative proposals developing current issues of cultural heritage, from assessment to protection and management.

The call included three main research topics to be developed:

- 1) *Safeguarding tangible cultural heritage and its associated intangible expressions.*
 - ✓ developing materials, technologies, procedures and systems for the long-term monitoring and maintenance of all forms of heritage (including modern heritage), taking into account integrity and authenticity of the different historical and environmental contexts and historical layers of cultural heritage;
 - ✓ investigating changes in landscapes, sites, structure and material in the context of different environmental and global changes (including insights into material decay etc), and also the relationship between material and the site itself;
 - ✓ developing tools for decision making based on integrated risk assessments (assessing value and loss of value for example).
- 2) *Sustainable strategies for protecting and managing cultural heritage.*
 - ✓ understanding how the significance and the values that landscapes, sites, buildings and artefacts hold for individuals and communities is influenced by global changes;
 - ✓ opportunities for the production, recognition, revitalisation and regeneration of landscapes, sites, buildings and artefacts (including digital heritage and digital representations of);
 - ✓ how the interaction and dialogue with heritage users influences the management of heritage and its environment;
 - ✓ the changing rights and responsibilities around cultural heritage including changing forms of access and governance, both nationally and more broadly;
 - ✓ understanding the meanings that cultural heritage holds for people and how they perceive, use and interpret it;
 - ✓ developing methodological tools for 'integrated landscapes'.
- 3) *Use and re-use of all kinds of cultural heritage.*
 - ✓ how to balance historical integrity and authenticity to ensure that the interpretations and management (including access) of landscapes, sites, buildings and artefacts by different publics are taken into account, including in pluralistic societies;
 - ✓ how built and natural heritage is affected by the rebalancing between the surrounding natural environment and cultural and societal developments,

- including regulation and an exploration of planning and architecture/design issues;
- ✓ an exploration of the contested and conflicting issues around access to cultural heritage, for example tourism vs. conservation, sustainability, authenticity etc.;
- ✓ exploring and integrating the available cultural heritage knowledge and information around use and reuse of heritage from different fields of study including, but not limited to, art history, science, digital heritage, conservation and maintenance, in order to move the field towards truly interdisciplinary heritage studies

The three call topics were identified in line with the principles and objectives of the Strategic Research Agenda (SRA) of the JPI Cultural Heritage and Global Change, and proposals could concern one topic or more, given the multidisciplinary character of the theme considered.

The call addressed to researchers community and was meant to support the scientific outcomes especially related to the tangible cultural heritage. In particular, considerable importance was given to those proposals focused on interdisciplinary solutions able to create knowledge and added value around the tangible cultural heritage while also exploring its intangible and digital aspects. The implementation of collaborative activities based on a multidisciplinary approach and the establishment of interconnections among different actors, researchers, policy makers and public and private stakeholders has also been considered as a priority in the assessment process.

The Heritage Plus Call was launched on the 3rd March 2014, with deadline for the submission of the pre-proposal on the 28th April. Applicants could find all detailed information on the submission in the "Guidelines for Application" through the JPI website (<http://www.jpi-culturalheritage.eu/wp-content/uploads/Heritage-Plus-Call-Guidelines-for-applicants.pdf>). These included:

- description of the topics
- eligibility criteria
- pre-proposal structure (application form, Description of Work)
- prescribed forms to use
- project structure to follow in the design of the partnership and roles of project partners
- eligible costs
- application procedures
- assessment procedures and criteria
- general suggestions


Over the submission period, Heritage Plus Task Leaders and Funding Partners provided support to Applicants in the preparation of pre-proposals, according to the Call procedures. WP3 Task Leaders guaranteed coherence of information and managed the application process with related electronic issues through the Electronic Submission Tool, which was improved following the experience gained in the First JPI JHEP Pilot Call.

2. Eligibility check

The call was actually successful and the **number of submitted Pre-proposals was 352**. For the full list see Annex 1, which includes acronym, full title, PL countries, topics, budgets.

Considering the 3 topics given by the Call, and the possibility of applicants to develop more than one issue, submissions were diversely distributed as per their first choice, according to Figure 1 statistics. Topic 1 (*Safeguarding tangible cultural heritage and its associated intangible expressions*) resulted as the most popular with 47% of Pre-proposals. At the second place, submissions addressed mainly to topic 2 (*Sustainable strategies for protecting and managing cultural heritage*) with 32% of Pre-proposals and finally, applicants developed topic 3 (*Use and re-use of all kinds of cultural heritage*) which represent 21% of total.

Figure 1 – Distribution of submissions per topics



A first eligibility check occurred between April, the 30th, and May, the 26th 2014, according to the given timetable, and was based on **National Eligibility Criteria** as reported in Annex A of the Guidelines (see D2.1 – *Set of Call documents*, including "Heritage Plus Call Guidelines for applicants"). The summarized criteria provide information on the group of subjects eligible for application, the available budget, and the maximum amount that could be requested per project along with contact details for participating agencies in each country.

Besides the National Eligibility Criteria, the Guidelines reported further standards:

- Only researchers located in the countries participating in the Heritage Plus Call were eligible to apply.
- Each project was required to comprise of at least three research Countries (and a maximum of five research teams), each from a different country participating in the Heritage Plus call and based in an eligible institution.
- Each participating researcher had to be based at an eligible institution and be considered eligible for funding by the funding organization(s) of the Heritage Plus country where he/she is located.

- Finally, the consortium had to demonstrate sufficient research capacity in order to achieve the project objectives and the management of the consortium had to be outlined and explained.

After the national eligibility check the number of not eligible proposals was 112.

According to this preliminary selection, the **number of eligible pre-proposals was 240**. For the full list see Annex 2, which includes acronym, full title, PL countries, topics, budgets.

3. Pre-proposal evaluation

The assessment of pre-proposals was undertaken by the Scientific Committee of the JPI Cultural Heritage and Global change, supplemented by additional experts identified by all the Heritage Plus Partners. On this purpose, 24 experts were involved in the **peer review Evaluation Panel**: 4 members of the Scientific Committee and 20 additional experts selected from the list of independent international experts proposed by the Heritage Plus Beneficiaries. Annex 3 reports the list of the experts.

MIBACT was responsible for the overall coordination of the call and worked together with MIUR in charge of overseeing the international peer review process.

The evaluation of pre-proposals by the Evaluation Panel took place from May, the 28th, to June, the 30th 2014. Each pre-proposal was sent to two reviewers for remote evaluation. Each evaluator received a maximum of thirty pre-proposals and was asked to fill in the evaluation form by the 4th of July. The WP3 Task Leaders paid attention to the balance of the geographical distribution of the proposals, topics and gender issues as much as possible, given the Scientific Committee composition and experts' availability.

The reviewers were asked to evaluate the proposals according to the **quality** of the research, the **compatibility with the scope** of the Heritage Plus Call, the **clarity of project** aims, work programme, outcomes, and the **added value** through transnational cooperation.

The two pre-proposal **reviewers** were also asked to draft on a set of general comments to be forwarded to all the pre-proposal Leaders. The aim of this request was to give applicants recommendations on how to strengthen their Full Proposal, in case of passing to Step two.

Evaluators were meant to assign a score ranging from 0 to 5.

Table 1 – Assessment range for Pre-proposals

SCORE	JUDGEMENT
0	The proposal fails to address the criterion or cannot be assessed due to missing or incomplete information
1	POOR - The criterion is inadequately addressed, or there are serious inherent weaknesses
2	FAIR - The proposal broadly addresses the criterion, but there are significant weaknesses
3	GOOD - The proposal addresses the criterion well, but a number of shortcomings are present
4	VERY GOOD - The proposal addresses the criterion very well, but a small number of shortcomings are present
5	EXCELLENT - The proposal successfully addresses all relevant aspects of the criterion. Any shortcomings are minor

Annex 4 reports the evaluation form used by experts to evaluate pre-proposals.

In July the 7th and 8th the Consensus meeting took place in Rome:

- to discuss commonly on the pre-proposals
- to agree on the Consensus Evaluation Form for each pre-proposal

- to propose the pre-proposal ranking list
- to propose to the Management Group criteria to select the pre-proposals to be passed to the second stage.
- to address to the Management Group comments and recommendations for improving the process of evaluation.

The output from the Consensus Meeting were sent to the Management Group on the 11 of July.

On the 17th – 18th July the Heritage Plus Management Group met in order to agree on the pre-proposals ranking list proposed by the peer review Evaluation Panel.

The number of the proposals admitted to the second step was 61, in line with the DOW statement, “the requested budgets of the proposals admitted into Step 2 cannot exceed about 3 times the total budgets committed by the Funding Partners for this call”. In Annex 5 the list of Pre-proposals selected for Step 2 following the decision of the Management Group, which includes acronym, full title, PL countries, topics, budgets.
