

The Humanities, Creation and Heritage University Research School (EUR) based at CY Cergy Paris University, in partnership with the Eutopia Alliance and the Campus Versailles, renews in summer 2023 the **International Heritage Sciences Summer School** within the same symbolic premises of last year: the King's Royal Stables in front of the Palace of Versailles.

The summer school will be conducted in English; therefore, participants should have at least a B2 level in English



*The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event depending on the number of participants.

If the organiser has to cancel the event, except in cases of force majeure, the participant will be fully reimbursed for the sums paid. The organizer may have to modify part of the programme or the speakers without prior notice and without giving the participant any right to compensation.

A certificate of attendance will be issued to all participants who request it, should they wish to value their participation through ECTS credits with their host institution.
